If not, type in your email address and password, then select "login" (2).

Select a tile, or swipe left to view all resources (2). All resources from the current month will appear. Select the month button to view resources from previous month (1). Any shared reports, weekly plans, or activities will appear with a paperclip icon (2) – select one of these resources to view or download the item. Any shared documentation from your child's teacher and observations you've sent to teachers will also appear (3) – select an observation to view or download the item. Select "touch here for options" to filter your view further, or to add and send observations to your child's teacher (4).
	 After selecting "touch here for options," select one of the first four filters to view specific types of resources (1). Observations from teacher: <i>GOLD</i>® documentation shared by your child's teacher Observations to teacher: family observations you've sent to your child's teacher Communications: any messages sent by your child's teacher Learning forms: any reports, activities, and weekly plans shared by your child's teacher Select "add observations" to add and send an observation to your child's teacher (2).
7) Add Family Observations	 After selecting "add observation," to send your child's teacher an observation (a note, picture, or video of your child demonstrating their knowledge, skills, and abilities), select your child (1). Type in a note (2). Select "add" to select a picture from your device (3). Note: at this time, you cannot upload a video. Select "done" (4). Your child's teacher now has access to the family observation. You can also add family observations on the family web application.
